To this end, we are happy to report that the two bus stops which we have erected in the vicinity of the entrance of the Argyle International Airport are officially open. In addition, we are in the process of installing an ATM at our head office in Kingstown which will enhance the ease of accessing cash and form part of our exciting thrust towards digitalization.

KCCU continues to modernize our services and advance new loan products with affordable terms to meet the needs of our members. Indeed, a record \$34.8 million in loans was disbursed in 2022, 45.6% more than the \$23.9M in 2019 (pre-covid). In just over 6 months, our recently launched Western Union Services at our Kingstown branch has facilitated an impressive 6,104 inbound transactions (valuing \$4.4 M), helping to further sustain our economy. Moreover, KCCU's 2022 Dance Festival event, which was held at Russell's Auditorium, was packed on all four nights and has truly become a household name. Further, our support to educational institutions across our country, in the form of sponsorships and donations, remains unmatched; so too our commitment to clean energy as we became the first private sector agency to establish a solar farm in 2022.

As we recover from the impacts of the COVID 19 pandemic and rise from the ashes of the La Soufriere volcano, let us continue to be our brother's and sister's keeper. Be assured that we, at KCCU, will continue to leverage all the financial tools available to support you.

Easter is a Christian festival which marks the resurrection of Jesus Christ. For many Christians, Easter is a celebration of the triumph of life over death, and a very important time of the year. Many non-Christians also have a holiday at this time, so it is a popular time to travel or spend with friends and family.

Easter in St. Vincent

In the weeks preceding the Easter holiday, Christians in SVG participate in religious ceremonies and other traditions. There is a strong belief that alcohol and meat should not be consumed on Good Friday, but instead sea foods such as mackerel, smoked herring, codfish are to be consumed. Hot cross buns, a favorite among islanders, are sold in bakeries throughout the country. Easter Monday is a national holiday. The general public has the day off, and schools and most businesses are closed. When there is enough wind around Easter, children and families enjoy flying kites. They were previously made of colored paper, plastic bags, and coconut tree branches for sticks, old clothes and newspaper. Nowadays, however, there are more store-bought kites than homemade kites. Other Easter celebrations that deserve mention include; egg hunting, painting eggs, rolling eggs down hills, and eating chocolate eggs.

The Bequia Regatta is held over the Easter weekend. The festivities begin on Good Friday and last until Easter Monday. One of the most popular events is the Easter Regatta (yacht races) which features Bequia and her neighboring islands competing on the sparkling waters around Bequia. Additionally, persons visiting can witness beach parties, live music, boat building and a variety of different private parties. In Port Elizabeth, the capital, there is also a street fair where you can sample local foods, drinks, and crafts. As active and enticing as these festivities may be, some persons from the mainland or other Grenadines islands simple venture to the island to unwind, relax and make use of the time off from the hustle and bustle of the usual work week.


KCCU Grenadines Fun Days

<u>EASTER EATS</u> HOT CROSS BUNS RECIPE

METHOD

- 1. Scald milk and pour in a large bowl.
- 2. Add sugar, salt, margarine and oil. Stir until fat melts.
- 3.Combine flour, yeast, cinnamon and currants. Make a well and add all the wet ingredients and stir together with a wooden spoon.
- 4. Turn the dough onto a floured surface and knead for about 10 minutes until smooth.
- 5. Cover with a damp towel and allow to ferment until doubled in size (about 30-45 minutes)
- 6.Cut into 16 even pieces and shape into buns. Place on a well-greased baking sheet. Cover with a damp cloth and allow to rise for about 30 minutes or until doubled in size
- 7.Put to bake in the pre-heated oven for about 15-18 minutes.

GLAZING

1. Mix the sugar and hot water until sugar is dissolved and brush on top of the finished buns.

ICING

1. Mix icing sugar, water and vanilla into a smooth paste. Add more icing sugar

if it is too runny.

2. Using a piping bag or tube; pipe crosses on the buns



Dough Ingredients:

- 1 cup of milk
- 3 oz margarine
- 2 tbsp oil
- 1 tsp vanilla
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 1/4 tsp salt
- 4 1/2 cups flour
- 2/3 cup currants
- 1 tsp cinnamon
- 1 tbsp instant yeast
- 1 large or 2 medium egg(s)

<u> Glaze Ingredients:</u>

- 2 tbsp sugar
- 2 tbsp hot water
- icing
- 1 cup icing sugar
- 2 tbsp water
- 1/2 tsp vanilla

This recipe can be utilized for family bonding or to simply reward yourself with a sweet treat!

The easter holiday allows you the opportunity to spend well needed time with friends and family. Here are some fun activities you can do with your family during the holidays:

Double Bunny Race

- Divide players into pairs.
- Each pair gets an inflated balloon.
- Mark start to finish lines about 40 feet apart.
- Each double bunny pair links their inside arms.
- When the leader says "GO", the pair then tries to make it to the finish line, while hitting the balloon to keep it in the air.
- If the balloon lands on the ground, it can be picked up, BUT if the pair unlinks arms, then they are disqualified

Backward Egg/lime Race

This is a relay race that can be done indoor or outdoor

- Divide the group into (2) teams, then divide the teams into (2) pairs.
- Each pair then stands back-to-back with their arms linked at the elbow.
- The first pair of players for each team is given (2) eggs. (One for each player)
- They then carry the eggs in their hand then the leader shouts "GO",
- The players race to the next linked pair in their team and transfer the eggs over, one at a time.
- The eggs continue to go from pair to pair until they are delivered to the last pair in the team.
- If an egg is dropped, the team has to go back to the starting line, (still connected) to get replacement egg(s).
- The first team to get their egg to the end of the row wins!
